

NatWest Group Know Your Credit Score Paris Olympics 2024 Prize Draw Terms

1. Prize Draw open to customers who register for the free credit score service provided by NatWest, opt-in to the prize draw, are aged 18 or over, and are UK residents (excludes Northern Ireland). How to enter

 - Two pre-allocated tickets to a Paris 2024 Olympic Games event (Athletics, Friday 2nd August 2024 10:00-13:00), purchased in advance by the Promoter.
 - Public Ground Transportation - Metro card received upon your arrival at the hotel that will enable you and your guest to use the Paris public transport system to get to the Olympic venues and other activities in Paris.
 - 3-night stay at the Hotel de Seze (1st August, 2024 – 4th August, 2024)
